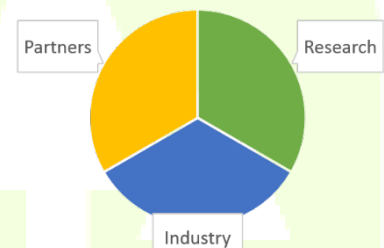


Edmundston, New Brunswick
